Termly assessments gathered by music lead and used to inform future planning.

All year groups use the Leicestershire Music scheme of work.

Singing is used within other subjects and especially in EYFS.

Regular extra-curricular music lessons available from outside agencies – popular with a good attendance.

Music objectives met within end of term performances – Christmas Nativity and Carol Service, Easter and end of year performances.

Whole school regularly singing in parts, led by the school choir.

Music store with instruments and electronic equipment to fulfil the scheme of work.
