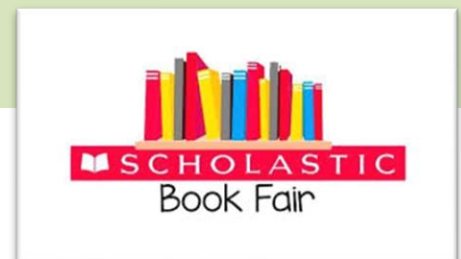
Choir Club:
