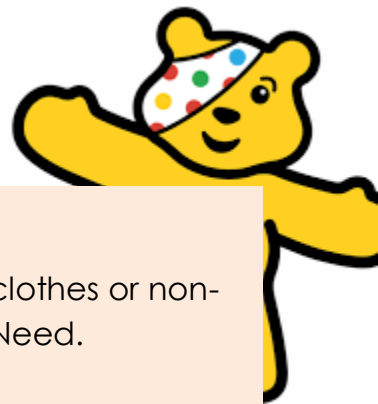


## Remembrance Day:
