For these sessions they will need to bring in their Bike and Protective equipment.



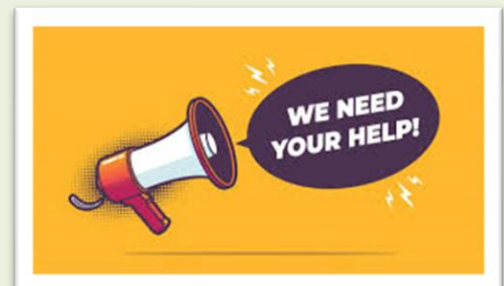
A Call for Volunteers!
